INTRODUCTION

The Torre Skating Club in partnership with Rollclub Skating School, with the patronage of the Federazione Italiana Sport Rotellistici – FISR and of the Associazione Italiana Cultura e Sport – AICS, in cooperation with the Town and local Authorities, organizes the Downhill World Championship valid for the World Skate and IGSA circuits.

All *in line* races shall endorse the WS (World Skate – www.inlinedownhill.com) regulations, the Skate Board and luge events shall be run in accordance with the I.G.S.A. regulations (International Gravity Sports Association - www.igsa.org).

All races shall be run downhill

2) CLASSES

Competitions are open to the following classes:

Open Skateboard IGSA (over 16) Women Skateboard IGSA (one class) Junior Skateboard IGSA (under 16) Open Luge IGSA (over 16) Open Classic Luge IGSA (over 16) Junior Luge IGSA (under 16) Master Skateboard IGSA (over 30) In Line Men **WORLD SKATE** In Line Women **WORLD SKATE Gravity Bike** (one class)

Events are open to male and female competitors, with separate rankings, exception made for the Luge discipline.

Participation of riders/inliners younger than 18 must be formerly approved by the parents.

3) COMPETITION TRACK

The competition track is mt. 1600 long, on the Strada Provinciale 43 Speronella, starting from the street number 14 (Castelnuovo), running along the Soccer playground, performing 3 straightaways, 3 curves and 7 hairpin bends with an average slope of 12%.

4) COMPETITION MODE

a) INDIVIDUAL RACE

Individual race on a time trial basis, valid as IGSA World Campionship ranking (2 runs) and as WORLD SKATE World Championship (2 runs and 1 final)

b) DIRECT ELIMINATION RACE – MASS RACE/BORDER CROSS

These races shall be performed with heats composed by 4 riders each, the first two passing on to the next stage, the 3rd and 4th ranked are eliminated.

The composition of the heats and finals is determined by the Technical Committee.

5) ENTRIES

The entries shall be done according to the procedures published on the official website www.euroskate.eu and WS Bulletin http://www.rollersports.org/component/phocadownload/category/283-bulletins.

6) REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

The following documents must be submitted upon registration at the organizing secretariat in Teolo:

- a) Valid ID document
- b) Acquittance and liability disclaimer
- c) Parental statement for underage 18

By signing the entry form and the liability exemption form riders declare to abide completely the present Regulations.

Prizes/reimburses shall be distributed at the competition office in the time schedule indicated by the Organisers and according to the formalities established by the Italian Law, within and not later than 10:30 PM of August 5, 2018. Prizes not collected within the indicated terms shall not be <u>assigned</u>.

JURY - TIMEKEEPING - FIRST AID

The Jury shall be designed by the Organizing Committee. The Timekeeping service will be accomplished by the Federazione Italiana Cronometristi. The First aid service shall be granted by the Italian Red Cross or Green Cross of Padua and by the medical officer appointed by the Organizing Committee.

8) WEATHER CONDITIONS

The Organisers shall have right to suspend the competitions and/or modify the programme in case of extreme weather conditions with no right of any financial claim from the participants.

10) SPORT RISK-TAKING

Each competitor shall carry out at least one controlled run to check the overall status of the protections and related risks. Should a fault or a poor protective action be detected, the competitor will be obliged to fill a written note, sign it and hand it to the race director (copy to the competition secretariat), who shall handle the matter accordingly.

11) WILD CARDS

The Organisers, in case of redundancy of entries, shall have right of rejecting entries exceeding the maximum number of allowed participants. The date of pre-registration within the indicated terms shall establish the priority.

If due to reasons unrelated to the will of the Organisers the events should not be competed in the established date, the events shall be adjourned to a time to be arranged with no right of any financial claim from the participants.

The Organising Committee refuses all responsibilities related to accidents and/or damages to people and/or things before, during and after the event.

For all provisions not mentioned in the present regulations it shall be referred to the IGSA and WORLD SKATE regulations.

The registration at the IGSA World Championship and the WORLD SKATE World championship involves the complete acceptance of the present regulation.
